

MINUTES FOR GIG HARBOR CITY COUNCIL STUDY SESSION

Thursday, April 13, 2023 – 3:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: Mayor Markley called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. Councilmembers Barber, Henderson, Lykins, Martin, Rodenberg, and Woock were present. Councilmember Storset was excused.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. **Wastewater Comprehensive Plan Amendment - Rosedale Preliminary Plat –** Public Works Director Jeff Langhelm reviewed the four available options for processing wastewater from the plat, including the applicant's preferred option and staff's recommended option.

General Council consensus was supportive of staff's recommendation to go with option #3. This item will come before Council for consideration at the May 8 regular Council meeting.


Council took a break at 3:58 p.m. and returned at 4:04 p.m.
