

**MINUTES FOR GIG HARBOR CITY COUNCIL STUDY SESSION**

**CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL:** Mayor Markley called the meeting to order at 3:03 p.m. Councilmembers Barber, Henderson, Lykins, Martin, Rodenberg, Storset, and Woock were present.
